Friends or Raddlebarn


The Friends of Raddlebarn AGM has been rescheduled for Wednesday 2 December at

Coronavirus

As part of the school community we will be asking you to:

Continue to ensure that the children have sanitised their hands after leaving the home/car

• Adults to wear a face covering, if not formally exempt and in this instance wear a lanyard or show the exemption card, whilst on the premises and in the queue (please don't be offended if you are asked to put on a face covering in order to enter the site)

- Talk to your child(ren) about the 'Hands, Face, Space' message and how they can be responsible for keeping themselves and others safe too.
