- Only bring in lunch bags/labelled medications and water bottles-no bags.
- Full uniform must be worn
- PE kit to be worn on PE days (please see class pages on the website for PE days)
- All devices loaned by the school for home learning need to be brought back on Monday with any charges and plugs
- Hot meals will be available for Early Years and KS1 as a trial. Cold meals will be available for KS2. If
 you want a meal provided for your child-you will need to book them on ParentPay. You can do this
 on the afternoon of Friday 5th March.
