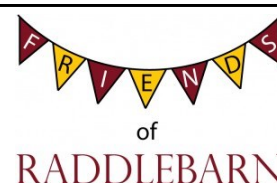
Thank you very much to everyone who donated money for this fun event. A fantastic **£211.34** was raised!
