The first round of the morning was to make a starter of vegetable spring rolls. The chefs did not know before the day what they had to make. The filo pastry proved a bit tricky but there was success for all 6 when by 10.30am they all presented spring rolls to the Judges.

Next was the main course and this was the finalists own recipe which they had practised at home. The standard was very high and the Judges were so impressed. There were pans bubbling away cooking a variety of food including quinoa, ratatouille pizza and pasta bake.

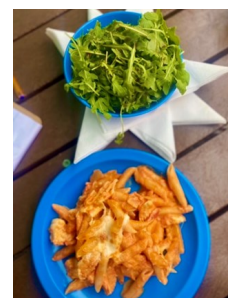
Arjun (Y3) and Sam (Y5) did a great job of taking photos and keeping our finalists on time by watching the clock.
